Martha has taught acting at New York University, Swarthmore College, Ryder University, Manitoba University, the Florence Voice Seminar in Italy, and she maintains a private studio for vocal and dramatic coaching in New York City.

As a singer, she performed extensively throughout her native Canada both as a concert and operatic performer, and has been heard on CBC's Arts National Radio in numerous recitals and orchestral concerts. Her televised appearances include Micaela in *Carmen* with Vancouver Opera and the opening gala of the world Expo in Vancouver, both of which were aired internationally.
